2. Registration

- A. Black Hawk East Campus Building B Room B222 (Soils Lab)
- B. Time 8:00-10:00 am
- C. Individuals will cost \$12/each for those registered more than 2 weeks in advance of the event for IAVAT Members (Checks made to IAVAT); \$20/each for those registered within 2 weeks of the contest

3. Scorecards, Tables, and Charts

- A. 100 point Land-Use Scorecards (Production Agriculture) will be used. Scantron forms will be used for scoring parts I, II, III, and IV.
- B. A table for Soil Judging Scorecard (Rev. 1984) will be provided to each contestant.
- C. Contestant will receive a table with the "C" factor for <u>Central Illinois</u>.
- D. Students must provide their own No. 2 pencil. The contest is scantron scored.
- E. Students will write the C value on the line marked "HOUR" on the front side of their scantron forms.
- F. Because of the increase in cost, teams should furnish their own organic matter charts.

4. Teams

- A. A team will consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 individuals, with the three highest scores counting for the team.
- B. Extra Individuals will be scored for individual awards only.
- C. Only one team per school may compete. An advisor must accompany their team.

5. Individuals

A. All individuals competing as a team or those from schools who do not have a full team, are eligible for individual awards.

6. Practice Pit

- A. A practice site will be located near the BHE Campus. Once a team has registered, they may go directly to the pit.
- B. Official results of the practice pit will be given at 10:00 am

7. Official Contest

- A. The contest site will be within a short driving distance from the East Campus.
- B. Four (4) pits will be included in the contest.
- C. Target rods will be at each site.
- D. Contestants are asked to bring their own hand levels.
- E. Contestant may <u>not</u> share calculators.
- F. The following information will be provided at each site and problem <u>not</u> related to the site will be calculated.
 - 1. Assumed slope
 - 2. Length of slope
- 3. Z factor
